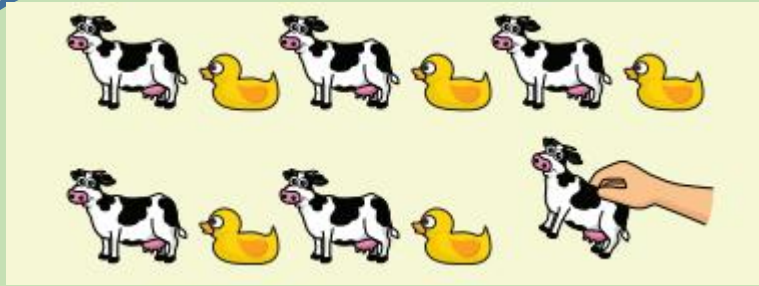


You can support your child by practicing singing these and other nursery rhymes regularly at home.

In our Little Wandle phonics sessions children will continue to learn..

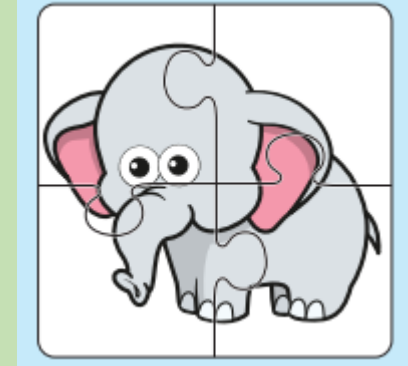
- How to identify initial sounds or words and names of objects through a range of fun games.
