

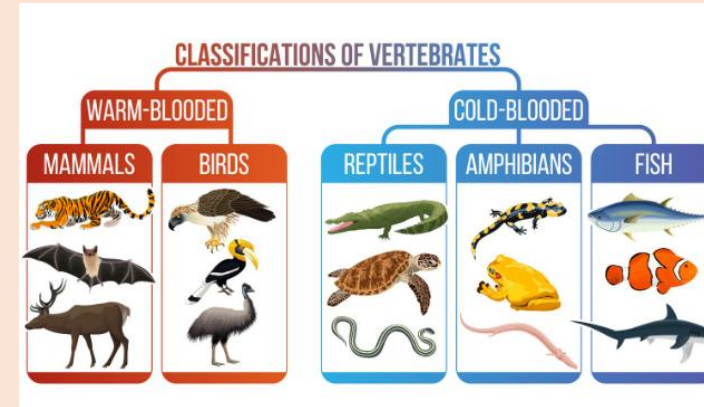
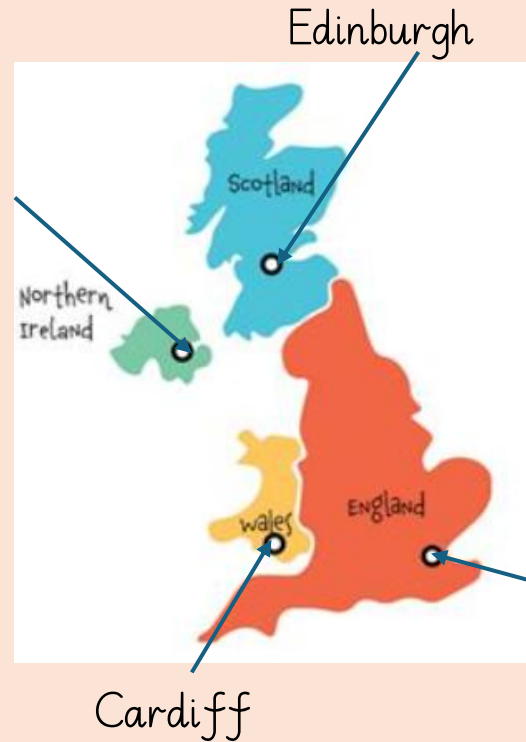

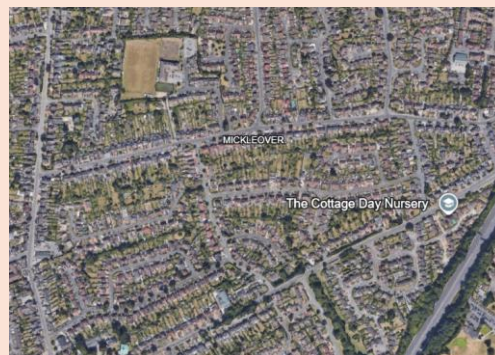

Key Vocabulary

Human features – Human features in geography are things that have been made by people.



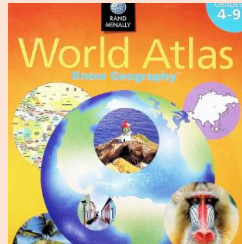
Physical features – physical features in geography are those that are natural features found on Earth's surface.



Aerial photographs – these are photographs taken from high up or above what you are taking a picture of.



Atlas – A book which includes a collection of maps.



Weather – weather is a description of what the conditions are like in a particular area.



Mammals – Mammals are animals that breathe air, have a backbone, grow hair and give birth to live young.



Fish – Fish are aquatic, gill-bearing vertebrate animals with fins.



Amphibians – Amphibians are cold-blooded vertebrate animals that live on land and water.



Reptiles – Reptiles are air-breathing animals that have scales instead of hair or feathers and are cold-blooded vertebrates.



Birds – Birds are warm-blooded vertebrates that breathe air, are covered in feathers, lay eggs and have two legs, wings and a beak.
