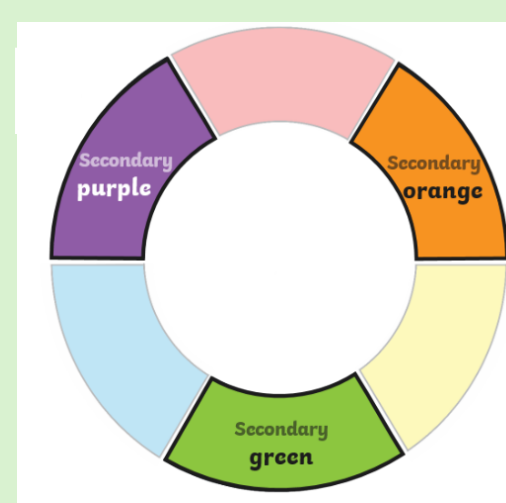


EVERGREEN





Red, yellow and blue are primary colours because they cannot be mixed from any other colours.



Orange, purple and green are secondary colours. You can create these by mixing primary colours together.



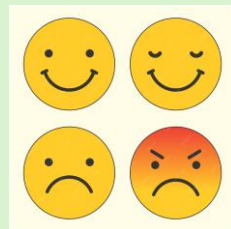
Watercolour: a type of paint used with water to give a transparent colour.
