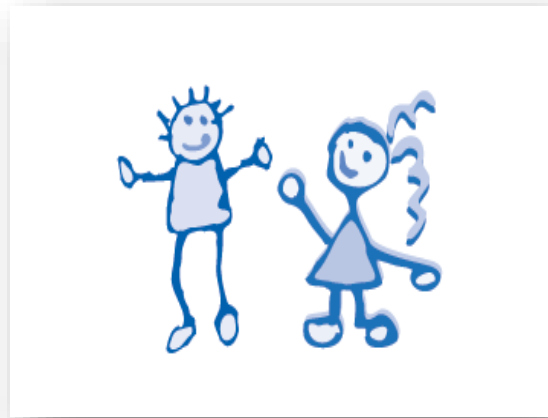

Mrs Hoyle and Mrs Lane are our friendly School Office team and serve as first point of contact for any queries or questions you may have.

We are proud to be a paperless school with all communications being shared online via email/Parent Hub/Parent Pay. Every half-term we send out a newsletter to let you know what has been happening in school.

Our School doors open at 8.40 am and registration takes place at 8.50 am every morning with sessions starting promptly after.

Finish times are 3.20pm.

If your child is ill, you will need to report their absence on the school attendance line.



# School Lunches & Snacks

- ▶ The school serves meals that are nutritionally balanced.
- ▶ Hot option and a cold option (no lunch boxes required).
- ▶ Select an option **WITH** your child and inform the teacher at the door every morning.
- ▶ The menus are available, along with the allergen information, on the school website.
- ▶ There is always a vegetarian option however the meat is **not** Halal.
- ▶ Please ensure the school has up to date information about any special dietary requirements.
- ▶ Class 'snack stations' with free school milk.
- ▶ All children have funded school meals up to Year 2.

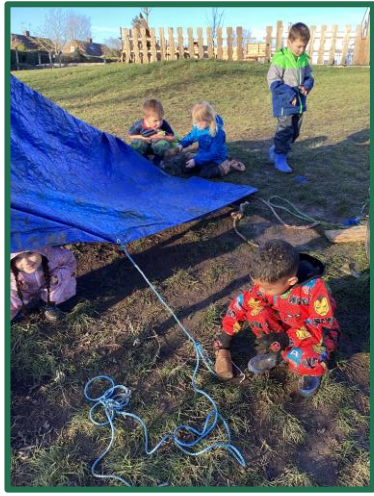

Shoes should be black, flat, sensible shoes that enclose the whole foot.

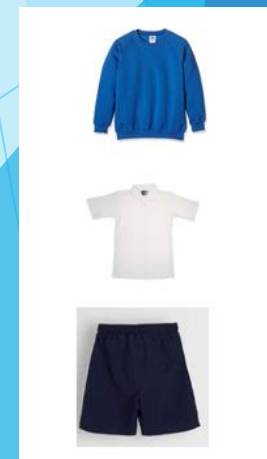
Embroidered sweatshirts, cardigans and polo shirts with the 'Ravensdale' logo.

## Medical Matters

- ▶ Where possible, all medicine should be given at home.
- ▶ Only medicine prescribed by a GP will be administered in school.
- ▶ You will need to **complete a form** available from the school office, to give permission for a member of staff to administer the medicine before your child comes into school.
- ▶ Parent/Carers are notified by Medical Tracker of any accidents.
- ▶ Head injuries – Medical Tracker – direct contact if needed.

# Things to bring to school

- ▶ **Suitable coat** – nothing too special as it is likely to get sandy, muddy or wet
- ▶ **Book bags**, reading records (school provided) and reading books (school provided). Books are checked and changed regularly. More information about helping your child to read will become available from September onwards.
- ▶ Hats, scarves and gloves
- ▶ Sun hats (please note, sunscreen should be applied at home)
- ▶ Water bottle
- ▶ All items, should be clearly labelled with your child's name.
- ▶ **'Curriculum' money** is asked to be paid at £1 per week. This covers any special days or cooking related activities. This must be paid via ParentPay. You may wish to pay termly.



# School Readiness – Our Ravensdale top ten..



1. To sit still and listen to adults and children
2. To be able to go to the toilet by themselves and wash their hands afterwards
3. To be able to put on and take off their coat and own shoes
4. To open and enjoy a book by themselves or with another person
5. To be able to hold a conversation with someone else.
6. To be able to recognise their name and have a try at writing some letters in it
7. To be able to sing a few familiar nursery rhymes
8. To take turns with other children when playing and join in with the play of others
9. To be confident to ask adults for help
10. To be able to count objects with care and use number names

- 2<sup>nd</sup>/ 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2025 – Settling in session 9:30 am – 11:30 am.

*Your child will be offered a dinner at 11:30am. You will need to stay with them so that you can support your child with having their first meal at school.*

- If your child currently attends a Nursery, we will phone them so that they can pass over any information that we need about their development. In some cases, we may visit your child at their current setting.

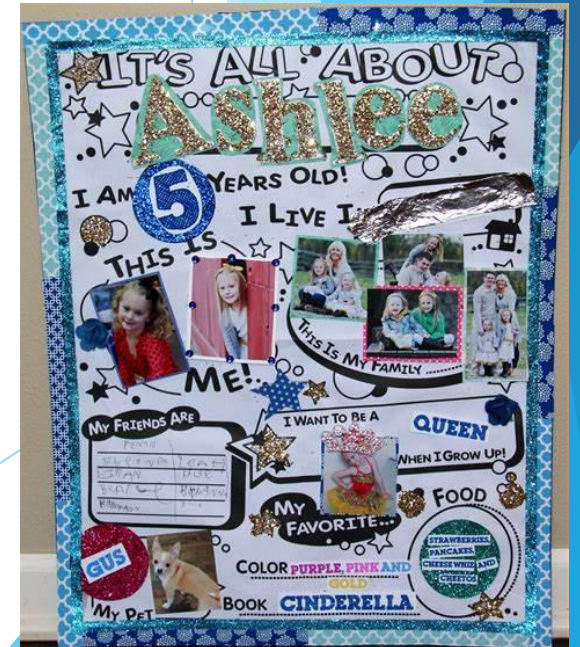
